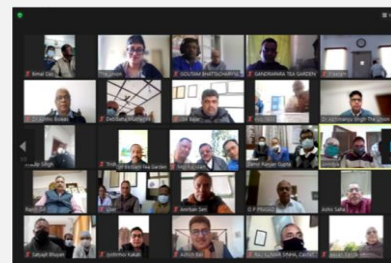
Inauguration of 3rd DMC by Goodricke Tea in Koomber Tea Garden hospital

Goodricke Tea inaugurated its 3rd DMC at Koomber Tea Garden hospital in collaboration with District Tuberculosis program, Cachar under Udharband BHPC on 22 Jan 2022. The inauguration was held at Koomber Tea Garden where Dr Bibhupada Nath, District TB Officer (DTO), health workers of the garden, welfare officer and other govt officials were present. Goodricke, with this new addition and existing chest x-ray facility, will continue to boost their TB elimination program & help in providing quality service to their workers dependents.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Orientation of Goodricke Tea Management on TB & Workplace Committee

Goodricke Tea initiated process to formulate TB Workplace Committee to plan and guide implementation of TB and workplace program. Senior Management officials, Medical Officers and Welfare Officers from 21 gardens participate in this committee formation meeting.



BEST, Mumbai promotes active TB screening for diabetes staff

BEST Mumbai in partnership with the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (BMC), initiated an intervention on screening all its staff with a history of Diabetes for TB through a mobile X-ray van. BEST has 26 bus depots across the city and close to 2500 Diabetic employees. The mobile x-ray van run by the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (BMC) will cover all 26 bus depots and screen all staff with diabetes history for TB using X-ray.

Fujifilm India Mobile X-ray Screening Intervention for TB

A second project review meeting for Fujifilms project was organized virtually on 17th January 2022, to broadly discuss the progress, identify the gaps and ensure that the community get benefited by utilizing easy access to services.



Review of DOW Chemical supported ACF project

Dow Chemical International Pvt. Ltd through its NGO partner plans to cover 10,000 households in Ambojwadi and Azminagar slums of Malad area, to identify symptomatic individuals and connect them to necessary diagnostics services under NTEP. A project review meeting was organized on 21st January 2022, virtually to broadly discuss the progress identify the gaps and plan next steps.

Software Refresher Training for the Fujifilm Project

Fujifilm India's project on "Mobile x-screening intervention for TB" is being supported by Qure Ai in which they have provided one qBox to offer AI based screening for chest X Rays. A "Software Refresher Training" was organized for the project team on 20th January 2022. 12 team members were oriented about the software and procedure of downloading the reports either in PDF or CSV files.
